

## **Utah Senior & State Amateur Qualifying**

Glenmoor Golf Course

Notice to Players



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

- **1. PLAY** will commence from the BLUE UGA Tee Markers for players competing in the State Amateur and Championship division of the Senior State Amateur. Super Senior and Net division players will play from the WHITE UGA tee markers and Women will play from the GREY UGA tee markers.
- 2. FAINT PAINTED LINES have no status.
- **3**. **FAIRY RING FUNGUS DAMAGE AND SEASONAL GROUND CONDITIONS:** Ground conditions that are thin or bare due to fairy ring fungus, drought or winter-kill have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such.
- **5. IN-COURSE OUT OF BOUNDS:** The white stakes between holes #5 and #6 determine the out of bounds for the play of hole #6 only. These stakes are immovable obstructions during the play of any other hole and are fixed boundary stakes during the play of hole #6.
- **6. 150 YARD ROCKS** are deemed to be immoveable obstructions.
- **7. HOLE #14: THE OUT OF BOUNDS ON THE RIGHT SIDE** is defined by a painted line and white stakes. Areas under construction that are not out of bounds will be treated as ground under repair.
- **8. SCORING AREA:** Is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tent. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions and the lines define the TIO.
- **9. OUT OF BOUNDS** is defined by inside edge of curbs, white stakes, property fence posts/pillars and telephone poles at ground level and white lines that connect them. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. If a ball crosses a public/private roadway and comes to rest on another part of the course, the ball is considered to be Out of Bounds. The maintenance road to the left of #10 is deemed not to be a road, it is an immovable obstruction. The inside edge of the telephone poles left of #18 supporting the netting define out of bounds.
- **10. TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last spot or alternate spots after 18 holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion of the round. All announcements regarding the play-off, including the sequence of holes, will be made at the clubhouse upon completion of the round.
