

Utah State Amateur Qualifying

Fox Hollow Golf Course

Notice to Players



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

PLAY will commence from the UGA BLUE Tee Markers.

RAILROAD TIES used as bunker retaining walls on holes #7 and #17 are immovable obstructions. During the play of *hole* #7, if a player has interference from the railroad ties, they may proceed under Rule 16.1 or as an additional option if the ball lies in the bunker, for one plenaly stroke, they may proceed to the **drop zone** located outside the bunker.

IN-COURSE OUT OF BOUNDS: The white stakes between holes #1 and #10 and between #4 and #7 determine the out of bounds for the play of hole #7 and #10 only. These stakes are immovable obstructions during the play of any other hole and are fixed boundary stakes during the play of hole #7 and #10.

HOLE #16: The Committee has deemed the cart path and area between the cartpat and fence behind the putting green and between the blue stakes, to be an integral part of the course. A player may play the ball as it lies, or proceed under Rule 19 (Ball Unplayable). As an additional option, a player may use the nearest Drop Zone located behind the putting green for a ball unplayable. (Marked "UGA DZ").

HOLE #16: If a ball is in yellow penalty area fronting the putting green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

- Take relief under Rule 17.1, or
- As an extra option, drop the original or another ball in the dropping zone located short of the penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under rule 14.3. Drop zone will be labeled "UGA DZ"

OUT OF BOUNDS is defined by inside points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts and public roads/curbs. Out of Bounds is also defined by of the inside edge of white lines identified as OB.

PACE OF PLAY: The UGA Checkpoint pace of play policy is in effect. See timing sheet online for times.

THE SCORING AREA is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions and the lines define the TIO.

TIES: In the event of a tie for the last spot or alternate spots after 18 holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion of the round. All announcements regarding the play-off, including the sequence of holes, will be made at the clubhouse upon completion of the round.
