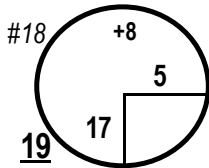
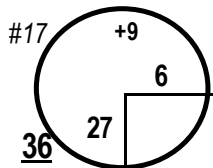
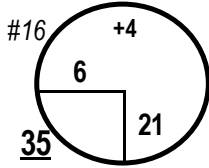
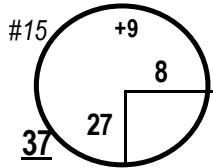
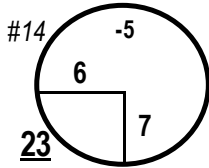
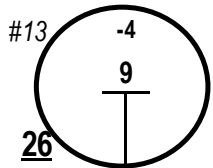
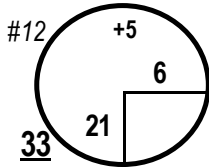
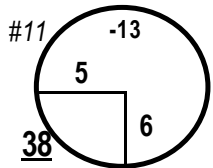
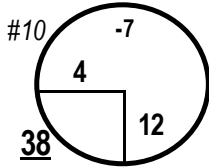
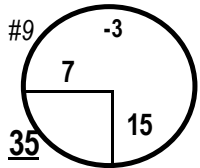
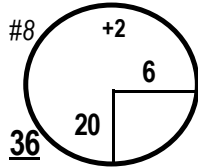
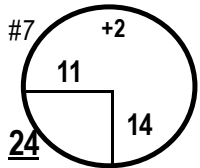
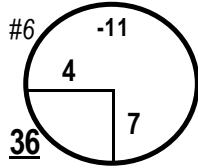
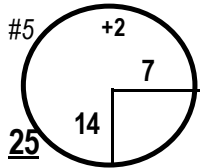
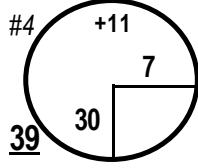
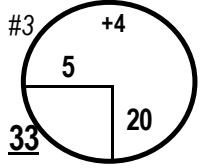
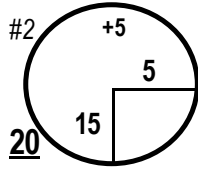
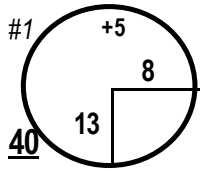


Utah Women's Stroke Play Championship

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)



1. TEES: FLIGHTS 1-3: UGA Blue Tee Markers
FLIGHT 4: UGA White Tee Markers

2. FORMAT: 36 holes of stroke play

3. BALL DEFLECTED BY POWER LINE If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line [or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line] during the play of [specify hole number], the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.6 for what to do).

4. BUNKERS: Bunkers are played as general area for the duration of this event. Players may ground their clubs and take practice swings. There is no relief from footprints, etc. Player must play the ball as it lies.

5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: 150 yard-marker rocks are deemed to be immovable obstructions.

6. OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of Bounds is defined by inside edge of roads, parking areas, white stakes, property fence posts or walls at ground level. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds.

7. SCORING AREA: The scoring area is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions and the painted lines define the TIO.

8. TIES: In the event of a tie for the overall championship, a hole by hole playoff will immediately follow play. Announcements will be made at the clubhouse.

9. PACE OF PLAY: UGA Checkpoint policy.
