## Utah Four-Ball Qualifying

Notice to Players



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

- 1. PLAY WILL COMMENCE** from the UGA Blue Tees for the Championship division and Senior Division, and the UGA White Tees for Super Senior division.
- 2. SEASONAL GROUND CONDITIONS:** Ground conditions that are thin or bare due to fairy ring fungus, drought or winter-kill have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such.
- 3. TOPPLED TREES** have been defined as ground under repair. A player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b if the ball is in the general area and 1) it touches or is in the tree or, 2) the tree interferes with the player's area of intended stance or area of intended swing.
- 4. BLUE STAKES and BLUE DROP ZONES:** A player may use the blue drop zone marked "UGA DZ" if a toppled tree has a blue stake in or adjacent to it as an additional relief option for ground under repair.
- 5. ADJACENT IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** are deemed to be one obstruction. Bare areas at the beginning and ends of cart paths are deemed to be part of the cart path.
- 6. OUT OF BOUNDS** - defined by inside points, at ground level, of white stakes, fence posts, public roads or rock walls. Out of Bounds is also defined by the inside edge of white lines or dots identified as OB. **A BALL** which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course.
- 7. DROP ZONE:** Is available as an additional relief option for a ball known or virtually certain to be in the penalty area (Yellow Only) on Hole #18. The drop zone will be marked "UGA DZ."
- 8. SCORING AREA:** Is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions and the painted lines define the TIO.
- 9. TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last spot after 18-holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion of the round. All announcements regarding the play-off, including the sequence of holes, will be made at the clubhouse upon completion of the round for each division.
- 10. SPOTS AVAILABLE PER DIVISION:**
  - Championship: 16 Spots
  - Senior: 8 Spots
  - Super Senior: 4 Spots
