Notice to Players



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

1. FORMAT: Four-Ball Match Play

2. TEES: Championship Division: White UGA Tee Markers

Senior Division: Blue UGA Tee Markers

Super Senior Division: Gray UGA Tee Markers

3. THE PAVED ROAD heading north and south out of the maintenance facility is an immovable obstruction.

4. PERMANENT ELEVATED POWER LINES - If a ball strikes an elevated power line, the stroke is canceled and the player must play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played. If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.

5. OUT OF BOUNDS is defined by White stakes, white paint dots and white lines on pavement/asphalt surfaces and property fence posts at ground level. The white line on the maintenance road left of hole #4 which ties in to white dots on the left of hole #5 defines out of bounds. The white line on the asphalt road on the left of holes #14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 defines the OB. White dots behind #18 green and around the clubhouse will define OB.

6. INTEGRAL OBJECTS: Paved surfaces adjacent to OB lines/Paint dots, that are in play, are deemed to be an integral parts of the course from which relief will NOT be granted. These areas are located left of holes 5, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18.

7. TOPPLED TREES have been defined as ground under repair. A player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b if the ball is in the general area and 1) it touches or is in the tree or, 2) the tree interferes with the player's area of intended stance or area of intended swing.

8. BLUE STAKES and BLUE DROP ZONES: A player may use the blue drop zone marked "UGA DZ and the hole number" If a toppled trees has a blue stake in or adjacent to it as an additional relief option for ground under repair. Blue drop zones have been labeled with the hole number they apply to.

9. BROWN STAKES down the left side of hole #14 have no status, and will be treated as immovable obstructions.

10. PACE OF PLAY: The UGA 40-Second Pace of Play Policy is in effect.

11. TIED MATCHES after 18 holes will be extended by as many holes as are required for the match to be won. The extension of the match will begin on the first hole.

12. MATCH WINNERS must report the results to the clubhouse. Results are officially announced when they are posted online.
