## **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships)

1. TEES: Men's Flights 1-3 – Black Tee Markers Senior Flights 1-2 – Black Tee Markers Senior Flights 3-4 – Blue Tee Markers Legends Flight 1 – Blue Tee Markers

- 2. FORMAT: 36 Hole modified Stableford format. Scoring will be as follows: 0 points for double bogey or higher, 1 point for Bogey, 2 points for par, 4 points for birdie, 6 points for eagle and 8 points for double eagle. Please record the gross number of strokes only on your scorecard. The computer will compute your stableford points. All players should pick up without finishing the hole once they have reached bogey, net players will pick up at net bogey. Players not picking up when requested and subsequently cause undue delay are subject to penalty as follows: First offense, Warning. Second offense Subtract 2 Stableford points. Third offense, Disqualification. Players are still required to record their most-likely scores on the said holes for handicapping purposes. All scores will be posted by the UGA.
- 3. **DECORATIVE ROCKS:** Decorative rocks are deemed to be integral parts of the course.
- 4. CART PATHS: Relief for cart paths (immovable obstructions) will only be granted for asphalt or cement paths.
- 5. **SEASONAL GROUND CONDITIONS**: Ground conditions that are thin or bare have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such.
- 6. **CONSTRUCTION AREAS**: If a ball comes to rest in an area of construction and you are unsure whether you are entitled to relief, play two balls and report to the committee after the round.
- 7. **NEW SOD**: Newly laid sod is deemed to be ground under repair. "newly laid" is defined as sod that has not been rooted into the ground yet. If sod has rooted, the sod seems rule on the UGA hard card will take effect.
- 8. **PENALTY AREAS**: When a penalty area is defined on only one side, it extends to infinity. When a penalty area is connected to the out-of-bounds edge, the penalty area extends to and coincides with out of bounds.
- 9. **THERE IS NO OUT OF BOUNDS** on the right side of hole #8.
- 10. **HOLE #18 OUT OF BOUNDS**: The white line to the right of the cart path on hole 18 defines out of bounds. A ball that come to rest, beyond the white line is out of bounds.
- 11. **FADED LINES** have no status. PVC posts not tied into out of bounds have no status.
- 12. **OUT OF BOUNDS:** In addition to the Local Rule, Out of Bounds is also defined by the inside edge of cement curbs that are adjacent to asphalt roads or property lines, homeowner walls, and public roads. (The Boundary starts and ends where Out of Bounds stakes join that inside cement curb). A ball which crosses a public road defined as Out of Bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is Out of Bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.
- 13. **SCORING:** Scorecards must be signed, attested, and returned to the scoring area, near the clubhouse after player has completed their round. Once a player has dropped their scorecard into the drop box, it is officially returned, and no changes may be made.
- 14. TIES: In the event of a tie in any division, there will be no playoff, and co-champions will be crowned.
