## Addition to the Notice to Competitors

## Model Local Rule E-3 is in effect.

When a player's ball lies in a part of the *general area* cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this *relief area*:

- **<u>Reference Point</u>**: Spot of the original ball.
- <u>Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point</u>: Two club lengths from the reference point, but with these limits:
- Limits on Location of Relief Area:
  - Must not be nearer the *hole* than the reference point, and
  - Must be in the *general area*.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for *replacing* a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

## Penalty for Playing Ball from a *Wrong Place* in Breach of Local Rule: *General Penalty* Under Rule 14.7a.

Please remember the following:

\*A player must lift and place the golf ball by using his hand, and not by merely bumping it with the club.

\*Once a golf ball has been placed on a spot in the relief area, that ball is in play, and must not be moved again, unless proceeding under a separate rule.

\*If a player's ball lies in an area of *Ground Under Repair*, he may take relief from the *Ground Under Repair*, and then may subsequently take relief under Model Local Rule E-3.
