Notice to Players



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

PLAY will commence from the UGA Tee Markers.

GROUND CONDITIONS that are thin or bare have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such. If a player believes they are in an area that would warrant relief from an abnormal course condition, they may request a ruling or may play two balls under 20.1c3.

PROTECTIVE REBAR STAKES AND ROPE are moveable obstructions and do NOT define any areas on the course.

BUNKERS are defined as sandy areas with rakes. DIRT AREAS WITHOUT **RAKES** are general area.

DROP ZONE: During the play of the 15th hole a player may use the Drop Zone located on the forward teeing ground as an additional option for a ball that is known or virtually certain to have come to rest in the red penalty area.

OUT OF BOUNDS is defined by inside edge of roads, white stakes, property fence posts or walls at ground level. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. A BALL which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course. The green staked orange fence to the right of #1 defines out of bounds. The course side edge at ground level of the black driving range poles defines out of bounds.

PACE OF PLAY: The UGA Checkpoint pace of play policy is in effect. See timing sheet online for times.

THE SCORING AREA is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions, and the lines define the TIO.

TIES: In the event of a tie for the last spot or alternate spots after 18 holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion of the round. All announcements regarding the play-off, including the sequence of holes, will be made at the clubhouse upon completion of the round.
