- 1. PLAY** will commence from the UGA Tee Markers
- 2. OUT OF BOUNDS** is defined by inside edge of roads, public sidewalks, white stakes, white lines, white dots, property fence posts or walls at ground level. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. The construction area to the left of Hole 10, behind Hole 11 tee, and to the right of Hole 12 is Out of Bounds and is defined by the green fence that borders it. The power poles that border the construction zone are considered immovable obstructions.
- 3. HOLES 2 & 6** – Drop zones are available as additional relief options for a ball known or virtually certain to be in the penalty area (Yellow Only). The drop zones will be located short of the penalty areas on each hole.
- 4. HOLE 5** – The Committee has deemed the cart path behind the putting green and between the blue stakes, to be an integral object. A player may play the ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 19 (Ball Unplayable). As an additional option a player may use the Drop Zone located behind the putting green for a ball unplayable.
- 5. HOLE 18** – The area short of the putting green and to the right of the penalty area is Ground Under Repair and is defined by white line. A player may play the ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 16.1. As an additional option a player may use the Drop Zone for a ball known or virtually certain to be in the Ground Under Repair. The Drop Zone will be located short of the area marked as Ground Under Repair. The drop zone will be labeled "UGA DZ – GUR." **A player must not use this drop zone as relief from the penalty area.**
- 6. RELIEF FROM SEAMS OF CUT TURF** - Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule F-7. Player may take relief for interference for lie of ball and swing only. Interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance. Please disregard signs posted around clubhouse stating the sod seams on hole #12 should be treated as Ground Under Repair.
- 7. TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last spot or the alternate spot after 18 holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion of the round. All announcements regarding the play-off, including the sequence of holes, will be made at the scoreboard upon completion of the round.
- 8. THE SCORING AREA** is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions, and the lines define the TIO.
- 9. PACE OF PLAY:** UGA Checkpoint Policy, see scorecard for times.
