THE ONE BALL RULE IS IN EFFECT

REPLACEMENT OF BROKEN OR SIGNIFICANTLY DAMAGED CLUB: Model Local Rule G-9 is in effect.

PLAY will commence from the BLUE USGA Tee Markers for the Boys' Division and the WHITE USGA tee markers for the Girls' Division. The Creekside Course will be holes 1-9, the Sunrise Course will be holes 10-18.

STONE PATHS AND DECORATIVE WALLS are deemed to be obstructions.

SANDY AREAS that do not have rakes are deemed to be part of the general area. Bunkers are sandy areas that have rakes.

GROUND CONDITIONS that are thin or bare have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such. If a player believes they are in an area that would warrant relief from an abnormal course condition, they may request a ruling or may play two balls under 20.1c3.

DROP ZONE: During the play of the 7th hole (Creekside #7) a player may use the Drop Zone located on the middle teeing ground as an additional option for a ball that is known or virtually certain to have come to rest in the red penalty area.

OUT OF BOUNDS - defined by inside points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts and curbing on public roads/parking lots. Out of Bounds is also defined by of the inside edge of white lines identified as OB. A BALL which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course. If a ball enters a tunnel that crosses under a road the ball is out of bounds, the inside edge of the beginning of the tunnel defines the OB. The course side of the sidewalk left of the cart path on hole 9 (Creekside #9), defines out of bounds.

SCORING AREA: Is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions, and the lines define the TIO.

PACE OF PLAY: UGA Checkpoint Policy (See scorecard for time of finish for each hole).

PLAYOFFS: Playoffs for qualifying spots and alternates will begin immediately following the conclusion of the qualifying round. Any playoff announcement will be made at the clubhouse.
