Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

1. **PLAY** will commence from the UGA Tee Markers.
2. **GROUND CONDITIONS** that are thin or bare have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such. If a player believes they are in an area that would warrant relief from an abnormal course condition, they may request a ruling or may play two balls under 20.1c3.
3. **MODEL LOCAL RULE E-3 IS IN EFFECT ON THE 10TH HOLE ONLY:**
 - i. "When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less on the **10th hole only**, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:
 - ii. Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
 - iii. Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: one club-length, from the reference point, but with these limits:
 - iv. Limits on Location of Relief Area:
 - i. Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and within one-club length.
 - ii. Must be in the general area.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.
Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a."
4. **IRRIGATION TUBES** are moveable obstructions.
5. **THE WHITE STAKES BETWEEN #1 AND #11** have no status except during the play of hole #9 where they define out of bounds.
6. **RED STAKED SMALL TREES BETWEEN #13 AND #18** are ground under repair.
7. **OUT OF BOUNDS** is defined by inside edge of roads, white stakes, property fence posts or walls at ground level. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. **A BALL** which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course.
8. **PACE OF PLAY:** The UGA Checkpoint pace of play policy is in effect. See timing sheet online for times.
9. **THE SCORING AREA** is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions, and the lines define the TIO.
10. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last spot or alternate spots after 18 holes of stroke play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion of the round. All announcements regarding the play-off, including the sequence of holes, will be made at the clubhouse upon completion of the round.
