

NOTICE TO PLAYERS



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

- 1. PLAY will commence from the UGA tee markers.
- **2. WALKWAYS COVERED BY MULCH OR WOOD CHIPS** are integral objects. Other areas covered by mulch or wood chips are not integral objects. In either case, the mulch and wood chips are loose impediments.
- **3. FLOWER BEDS THAT ARE NOT IN PENALTY AREAS:** If a ball comes to rest in a flower bed, or if a flower bed interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball **must be lifted**, without penalty, **and dropped** in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16 (Abnormal Course Conditions). The ball may be cleaned when lifted under this local rule. **(Flower Beds Must Have Flowers in Them).**
- **4. THE YELLOW PENALTY AREA** located on hole #4, is deemed to be a red penalty area during the play of any other hole.
- **5. HOLE #4:** If a ball is in yellow penalty area fronting the putting green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
- Take relief under Rule 17.1d(1), 17.1d(2), or:
- As an extra option, drop the original or another ball in the dropping zone located short of the penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under rule 14.3. The drop zone will be labeled "UGA DZ".
- **6. HOLE #16**: The Committee has deemed the cart path behind the putting green and between the blue painted dots, to be an integral object. A player may play the ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 19 (Ball Unplayable). As an additional option, a player may use the nearest Drop Zone located behind the putting green for a ball unplayable.
- **7. A BALL** which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course.
- 8. FAINT PAINT LINES have no status.
- **9**. **BLUE DOTS** identifying the front and the back of greens have no status, and relief from the dots will not be granted.
- 10. PACE OF PLAY: The UGA 40-Second Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
- **11. IN THE EVENT A MATCH IS TIED** after 18 holes, the stipulated round will be extended by as many holes as are required for the match to be won. The extension of the match will be determined by the committee.
- **12. MATCH WINNERS** must report the results to UGA Headquarters in the Clubhouse. Results are officially announced when they are posted online.
