Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for USGA Championships.)

1. PLAY will commence from the USGA Tee Markers.

2. THE ONE BALL RULE IS IN EFFECT

3. REPLACEMENT OF BROKEN OR SIGNIFICANTLY DAMAGED CLUB: Model Local Rule G-9 is in effect.

4. BALL PLAYED FROM OUTSIDE RELIEF AREA WHEN TAKING BACK-ON-THE-LINE RELIEF: Model Local Rule E-12 is in effect.

5. RODENT DAMAGE: Interference includes lie of ball and area of intended swing, but does not include stance.

6. HOLE #15: If a ball is in the red penalty area fronting the putting green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the red penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

i. Take relief under Rule 17.1, or

ii. As an extra option, drop the original or another ball in the dropping zone located short of the penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under rule 14.3. The drop zone will be labeled "UGA DZ".

7. SEASONAL GROUND CONDITIONS: Ground conditions that are thin or bare due to drought or winter-kill have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such.

8. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: The following are immovable obstructions from which relief may be taken in accordance with 16.1:

- Stone or gravel immediately adjacent to artificially surfaced roads/paths, including curbing, and stone markers.

9. OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of Bounds is defined by inside edge of roads, white stakes, property fence posts or walls at ground level. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. The buck-and-rail fences are considered to be out of bounds and the margin is defined by the inside edge of the inner-most posts at ground level.

A BALL which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course.

10. MAINTENANCE ROAD: The maintenance road is deemed to be a cart path and relief is available under Rule 16.1.

11. SCORING AREA: Is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions and the painted lines define the TIO.

12. PACE OF PLAY: The UGA Checkpoint pace of play policy is in effect. See scorecard for times.

13. PLAYOFFS: Playoffs for qualifying spots and alternates will begin immediately following the conclusion of the qualifying round. Any playoff announcement will be made at the scoreboard.

14. QUALIFYING SPOTS: Three qualifying spots and two alternates
