# Utah Women's Stroke Play Championship

Notice to Players



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for UGA Championships.)

- 1. PLAY WILL COMMENCE** from the UGA BLUE Tees for Flights 1-3 and the UGA WHITE Tees for Flight 4.
- 2. HOLE #8:** During the play of the Hole #8 a player may use the Drop Zone located on the forward teeing ground as an additional option for a ball that is virtually certain to be in the penalty area (Yellow Only).
- 3. SEASONAL GROUND CONDITIONS:** Ground conditions that are thin or bare due to drought or winter-kill have not been marked as Ground Under Repair nor will be played as such.
- 4. OUT OF BOUNDS:** Out of Bounds is defined by inside edge of roads, white stakes (wooden or pvc white posts), property fence posts or walls at ground level. When defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds.
- 5. PERMANENT ELEVATED POWER LINES** - If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.60 for procedure).
- 6. THE SCORING AREA** Is defined by the painted lines around the scoring tents. The scoring tents are temporary immovable obstructions and the painted lines define the TIO.
- 7. TIES:** In the event of a tie for the overall championship, a hole by hole playoff will immediately follow play. Announcements will be made at the scoreboard.
- 8. PACE OF PLAY:** UGA Checkpoint policy.
