



UTAH WOMEN'S FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP

Toana Vista Golf Course

June 1-2, 2022



(This information supplements the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for UGA Championships)

FORMAT: Play will be 36-holes of four-ball stroke play.

PLAY will commence from the **WHITE UGA TEE MARKERS**.

MODEL LOCAL RULES E-3 IS IN EFFECT (PREFERRED LIES). See "Addition to the Notice to Competitors" for additional information.

FLOWER BEDS: Flower beds on holes 3 & 12 are considered to be Ground-Under-Repair. Relief without penalty may be taken.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: The following are immovable obstructions from which relief may be taken in accordance with 16.1:

- 150-yard marker rocks and rocks with writing

- The chicken wire and any stake and rope around trees or other foliage

NO PLAY ZONE – ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITION: The tarp on the fairway of Hole 15 is defined as a No Play Zone in which free relief must be taken in accordance with 16.1.

RELIEF FROM BURROWING ANIMAL HOLES; SOD SEAMS; TREE WELLS: Except in a penalty area, a player may take relief from the seams of newly planted sod; burrowing animal holes; and constructed tree wells including drip systems; however, the relief from these conditions is limited to the lie of the ball and swing only and not for stance.

THERE ARE NO DROP ZONES on the golf course. All course signage should be disregarded.

CART PATHS are defined as those paths that have been specifically surfaced by black top or cement. All other paths, trails and roadways are deemed to be integral parts of the golf course including crushed gray rock.

FAINT PAINT LINES should be disregarded.

OUT OF BOUNDS - defined by inside points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts and curbing on public roads/parking lots. Out of Bounds is also defined by the inside edge of white lines identified as OB.

A BALL which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of course. If a ball enters a tunnel that crosses under a road the ball is out of bounds, the inside edge of the beginning of the tunnel defines the OB. The course side of the sidewalk left of the cartpath on hole 9 (Creekside #9), defines out of bounds.

SCORING: Scorecards must be signed, attested, and returned to the UGA table on the back patio of the clubhouse after player has completed their round. A scorecard has been returned when the player has returned the card to a committee member.

PACE OF PLAY: 4:35 minutes.

TIES: There will be no playoff and co-champions will be crowned.
